During the week prior to the 2006 Census, 1,805 people aged 15 years and over who were usually resident in Colonel Light Gardens (Suburb) were in the labour force. Of these, 57.5% were employed full-time, 34.4% were employed part-time, 3.5% were employed but away from work, 1.8% were employed but did not state their hours worked and 2.8% were unemployed. There were 617 usual residents aged 15 years and over not in the labour force.

In Colonel Light Gardens (Suburb), of the occupied private dwellings being rented, 39.4% were rented from a real estate agent, 6.6% were rented from a State or Territory housing authority and 50.4% were rented from other landlord type. In comparison, in Australia 50.5% were rented from a real estate agent and 14.9% from a state or territory housing authority.
